## **5th Grade Supply List**

Each student will need a medium to large backpack to carry books. Some NCCA students prefer to use rolling bags. Many also find it easier to have two backpacks: one for Monday and one for Wednesday. Each student will also need a container to carry pencil and pens (a pencil box or pouch).

## **5th grade supply list:**

Please label all supplies with the student's name:

- 1 shoebox sized plastic container to be left at school containing:
  \*1 box of colored pencils or markers, \*glue stick(s)
  \*scissors, \*1 pack of 3x5 note cards, \*extra pencils and eraser, \*12 inch ruler marked with inches and centimeters, \*3-4 dry erase markers and a dry erase eraser or sock, \*extra red pen
- 1 small box of tissues
- 1 pack of sanitizer wipes to be left at school
- Loose leaf, college or wide ruled notebook paper to use throughout the year. Place some in the back of each class binder.
- A pack of pencils, dark blue or black ink pens, and at least 2 red pens
- 4--1 inch binders
- 2- 70 page spiral notebooks for Math
- 1 composition book to be used as a journal (70 to 100 sheets is sufficient) (First Semester)
- 1 small binder with 3 hole punched folder labeled "Creative Writing" (2nd Semester)
- Bible (First Semester Only--see Bible section below for suggested versions)
- 6--2 pocket folders with 3 holes punched to fit in a binder--no fasteners inside
- 8--3 hole punched tab dividers with pockets to go inside of binders

## **Information for labeling supplies in each subject area:**

English

- 1--1 inch 3 ring binder covers. Write the student's name and "English" on the front of the binder.2--3 hole punched tab dividers with pockets to go inside the binder. Label each of them as follows: 1) Grammar and 2)Writing
- 1--2 pocket folders with 3 holes punched to fit in your English binder (for writing assignments). On one side write "Assignments Due" and on the other pocket write "Assignments Completed".
- Composition book to use for assigned journaling (1st Semester)

Science

- 1--1 inch 3 ring binder covers. Write the student's name and "Science" on the front of the binder.
- 2 pocket folders with 3 holes punched to fit in your Science binder (for writing assignments). On one side write "Assignments Due" and on the other pocket write "Assignments Completed".
- 2--3 hole punched tab dividers with pockets to go inside the binder. Label each of the dividers as follows: 1) Notes/Handouts/Vocabulary (one divider) and 2) Quizzes, Tests

History

- 1--1 inch 3 ring binder. Write the student's name and "History" on the front of the binder.
- 1--2 pocket folders with 3 holes punched to fit in your History binder. On one side write "Assignments Due" and on the other pocket write "Assignments Completed".
- 2--3 hole punched tab dividers with pockets to go inside the binder. Label each of the dividers as follows: 1) Notes/Handouts/Vocabulary (one divider) and 2) Quizzes/Tests

Bible (first semester) and Literature (second semester):

- A non-paraphrased version of the Bible (suggested: New International Version, New American Standard, English Standard Version, New King James Version). Please put your student's name in his/her Bible.
- 1--1 inch 3 ring binder with a pocket on the inside of the front and back covers. Write the student's name and "Bible/Literature" on the front of the binder.
- 1--2 pocket folders with 3 holes punched to fit in your Bible/Literature binder (for writing assignments). On one side write "Assignments Due" and on the other pocket write "Assignments Completed".
- 2--3 hole punched dividers with pockets to go inside the binder. Label each of the dividers as follows: 1) Notes/Handouts/Vocabulary (one divider) and 2) Quizzes/Tests

Math

- 2-- 70 page spiral notebooks to be used for daily homework. (You might want to pick up 2 extra in case the originals are used up)
- 1--2 pocket folders for any extra assigned practice or notes. On one side write "Assignments Due" and on the other pocket write "Assignments Completed".
- 12 inch ruler labeled that includes centimeters
