****Please purchase and label the following items to bring to school on the FIRST day.**

- Planner (weekly/monthly planner of your choice- be sure there is enough space to write down H.W.)
- Back Pack
- Pencil Box or Bag
- Blue or black ink pens
- #2 lead pencils (mechanical is fine but you must have refills)
- 1 package- red pens
- Loose leaf college-ruled paper (LOTS FOR EACH CLASS—in their binders)
